* Campfires are to be held in authorized Fire Pit only.

* Personal food may not be stored in walk-in cooler or freezer in the dining hall.

Disruptive Behaviour

Violent and aggressive behaviour has no place at the campout. Anyone displaying this behaviour will receive a letter and may be asked to leave, pending the outcome of an open meeting of the campout committee. The party in question will be invited to attend such meeting.

Facility Information

This campground facility provides areas for tents and RV's. electrical & water hook-ups are available. Safe drinking water is present. There are cabins and a dormitory available on a lottery basis. This facility is wheelchair accessible. You must supply your own bedding, insect repellent and toiletries. Recycling bins will be available on site.

Washer/dryer (coin operated), washrooms, showers and dock

Meals

Meals are available or you can bring your own food, cooler and camp stove. Meals are \$12.00 for Adult and \$6.00 for Children 5 to 12. Children under 5 eat free. On the first day of campout there is only one meal (supper) and on the last day the meal is a free brunch. Meal times are 10:30 am and 5:00pm. Notify committee of any food allergies prior to arrival.

Waiver to be signed at registration.

In light of complaints from neighboring campers, the campout committee must insist that rooms or cabins assigned to families include a responsible adult who will reside in the assigned place.

The campout committee finds it necessary to request that campers who do secure a room or cabin at the campsite, sign a consent.

Please be advised not to rely on the Higher Power Fund to finance your entire campout. Funds are limited.

You can access the Fund for two years only.

First year the Higher Power fund is available for registration and meals.

Second year the Higher Power fund will cover only meals. Registration will be your responsibility.

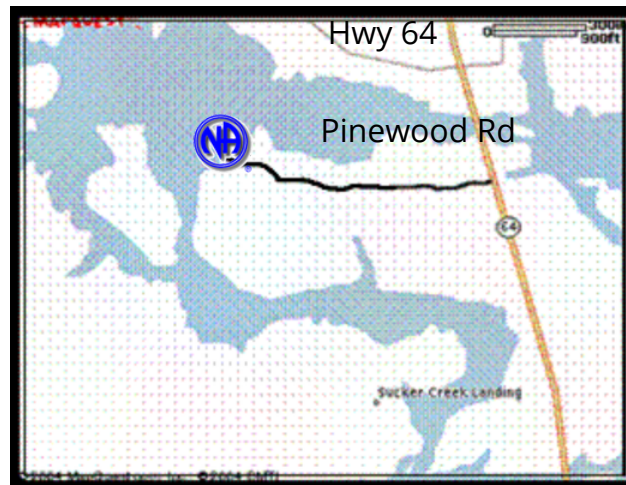
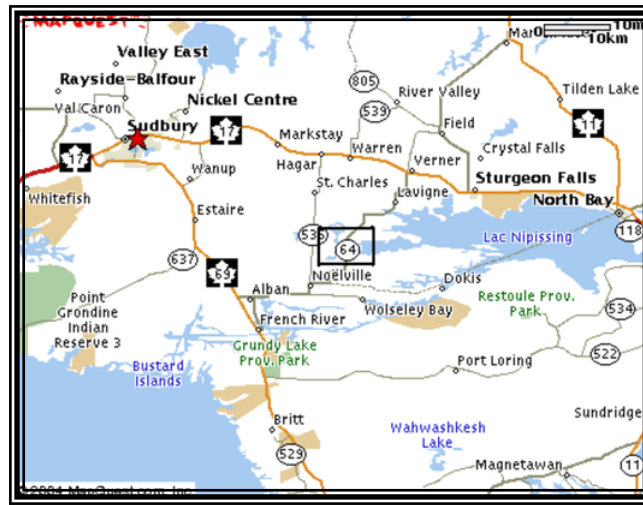
